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Description: Pathogen Inactivation of platelets is becoming more prevalent and more hospitals are requesting them. The lecture will address the benefits of the products, as well as how the process is performed in the manufacturing lab, how the inventory is monitored at the hospital and by the distribution center to minimize wastage - discard or the unnecessary manufacture of the products. OneBlood has implemented the technology of the lab and is providing 100% PRT platelet products to a few large organizations and to a few very small ones; I will summarize how the implementation process was managed to complete a smooth transition in all areas of the hospital.
