2. Applicant must be an individual member of SCABB for a period of not less than 12 months, or if less, show record of involvement in the Association since joining. (Membership must be in good standing.)
3. Applicant must be willing to write either a blog or article for SCABB summarizing one or more of the education sessions attended at the Annual Meeting within 30 days of the conclusion of the Annual Meeting, if chosen as the Raymond St. Peter Annual Meeting Scholarship award recipient.
