Description: South Central Association of Blood Banks Institutional Members share their most interesting Immunohematology cases.

Case # 1: Case Study with a Complement Fixing Antibody | Joe Serna, MT(ASCP)

Obj: Understand relationship between Kidd antibodies and Complement

Description: Presentation will follow two workups of the same patient 11 days apart illustrating to differences. Will discuss Complement and why it stops at C3 versus going on to lyse cells. Will discuss relationship between Kidd antibodies and complement fixation.

Case # 2: A Rare but Serious Event | Richard Gammon, MD

Obj: Gain an understanding of the role ABO antibodies play in platelet transfusions

Description: This case study will review an unusual reaction that occurred after transfusion of pooled platelets. The investigation and hospital course will be covered. The presentation will end with a brief review of the literature.

Case # 3: Assessing Serological Results While Correlating Molecular Genotyping | Amy Johnson, MT (ASCP)

Obj: Discuss the challenges of warm autoantibodies in a new molecular world

Description: With molecular genotyping becoming more prevalent, a case study will be presented assessing serological results while correlating molecular genotyping. Limitations and challenges will be discussed, as well as, how to use these tools most effectively.

Case # 4: Anti-body ID Tour de Force | Cindy Steimetz, MT(ASCP)SBB

Obj: Confirm the importance of communication between all team members and correct patient history.

Description: How do you handle multiple transfused sickle patient when you don't have much history? This particular demographic makes antibody identification difficult in some instances. We will see some of the steps you have to use to get answers we need when working on complex cases.

Level of Difficulty: Beginner and Intermediate
